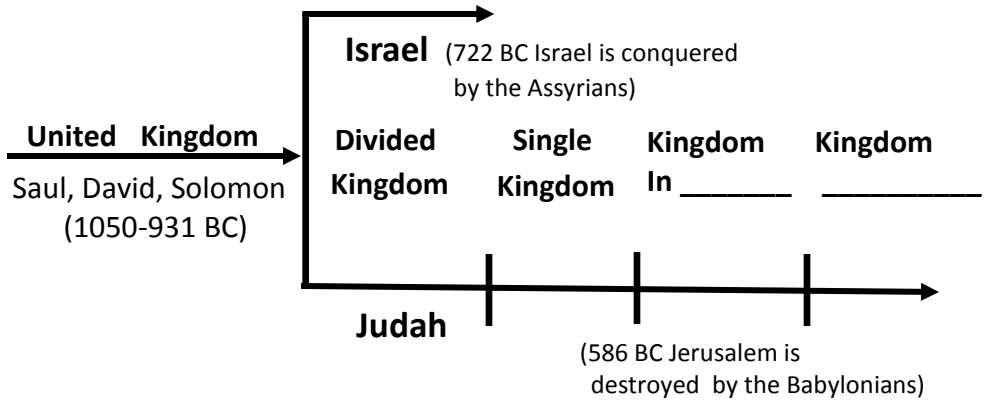


# The Old Testament for Dummies: Week 7 – The Exile Period

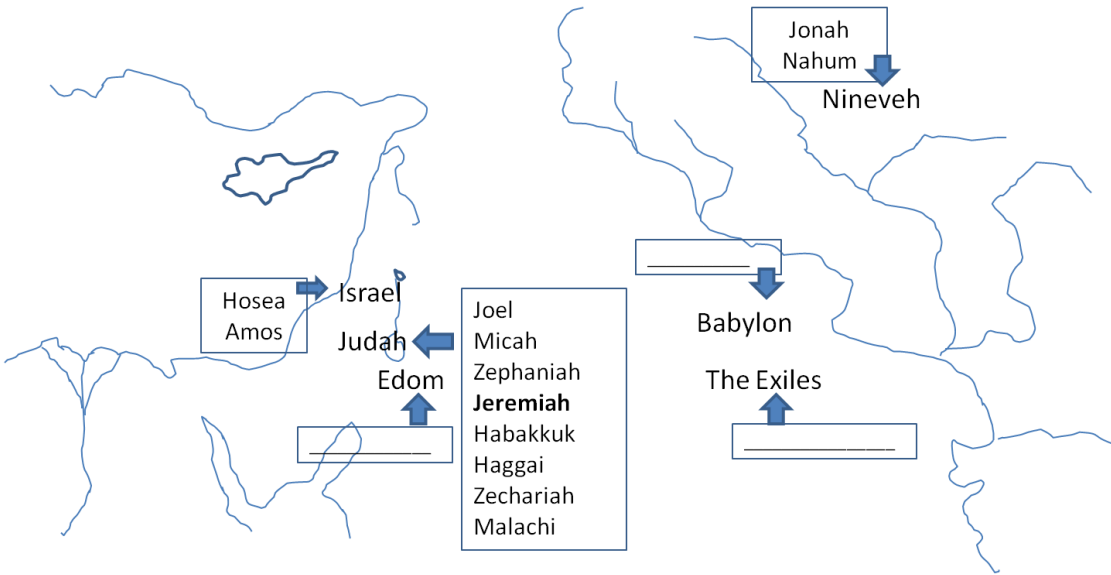
## The Kingdom Periods of History in the OT.
