

- 1 We are saved by God's grace alone through faith alone in Jesus alone (Ephesians 2:8-9; John 3:16; 14:6)
- We are not saved by works of the law (Romans 3:20-24; Galatians 2:16; 3:11)
- We are no longer under the law; now we are under grace (Romans 6:14-15; Galatians 5:18)
- 4 This does not give us a license to sin (Romans 6:1-2)
- 5 Even after salvation we do not depend on the law in order to please God (Romans 7:4-6, 21-25)
- **6** Even after salvation we must depend on Jesus (*John 15:1-5*)
- **7** We obey the spirit of the law, not the letter of the law (2 Corinthians 3:6; Galatians 5:22-23)
- Christianity is not a list of rules & regulations, but a personal love, trust relationship with the Lord Jesus. Obedience = faith + love in action
 (Romans 3:31: 13:10: Mark 12:30-31)
