The Four Major Subjects of the Doctrine of Salvation:

- 1. _____: Salvation is a gift God gives to those who believe. Ephesians 2.8-9: For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.
- 2. _____: God extends forgiveness of sin and eternal life to those who receive him. John 20.31: You may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
- 3. _____: The penalty of sin is paid for by the substitutionary death of Christ. 1 Peter 3.18: For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God.
- 4. _____: Our salvation will be complete when Jesus returns, raising and transforming our physical bodies.
 Romans 8.23: We wait eagerly for . . . the redemption of our bodies.
