### A Review of the Doctrine of the Salvation:

- 1. \_\_\_\_\_: Salvation is a gift God gives to those who believe.
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_: God extends forgiveness of sin and eternal life to those who receive him.
- 3. \_\_\_\_\_: The penalty of sin is paid for by the substitutionary death of Christ.
- 4. \_\_\_\_\_: Our salvation will be complete when Jesus returns, raising and transforming our physical bodies.

### The Four Major Subjects of the Doctrine of the Church:

- 1. \_\_\_\_\_: The universal church is the totality of all believers in Jesus. Ephesians 5.25: Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.
- A local church is a gathering of believers organized to carry out the responsibilities of the universal church. Romans 16.5: Greet also the church in their house.
  1 Corinthians 1.2: To the church of God that is in Corinth . . . Called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3. \_\_\_\_\_: Leadership in the local church is entrusted to the spiritually mature. *Titus 1.7*: For a [church leader], as God's steward, must be above reproach . . .
- 4. \_\_\_\_\_: Believers belong to a universal church and partner with a local church for ministry Hebrews 10.24-25: And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together.
