## ROMANS: A Theological Glossary

SIX REASONS JESUS AND THE GOSPEL ARE SO OFFENSIVE (DON'T BURY THE LEAD!)



- Jesus and the gospel are a stumbling block for anyone trying to \_\_\_\_\_\_ their salvation.
