## ROMANS: A THEOLOGICAL GLOSSARY

- While many Israelites rejected Jesus, God \_\_\_\_\_ all Israelites.
    - » God didn't reject \_\_\_\_\_.

    - » In O.T. times, Elijah was \_\_\_\_\_ faithful Israelite left.
    - » In N.T. times, God saved a \_\_\_\_\_ chosen on the basis of his grace.
  - God has further \_\_\_\_\_ those Israelites who rejected Jesus.
  - \_\_\_\_\_: The people of Israel in general. In Romans, Paul mostly uses the terms Jews, Israelites and Hebrews interchangeably to identify God's chosen people.
  - \_\_\_\_\_: God before the creation choosing some people to be saved, not on account of any foreseen merit in them, but because of his sovereign grace.
  - \_\_\_\_\_: God's personal knowledge before the creation of those people he would save. People believe and are saved because God chose and foreknew them.
  - \_\_\_\_\_: The grace of God that saves a person. God's saving grace is completely his gift. Even our ability to accept his saving grace is simply another gift from God.
  - \_\_\_\_\_: A leftover amount from a larger portion or piece. In Romans, the remnant are those "few" persons whom God chooses to save out of the larger whole.
