- The destinies of the Israelites and the Gentiles are indefinitely \_\_\_\_\_.

- \_\_\_\_\_: From the Hebrew word for "*nation*," a person who is not a Jew. In Bible times, Gentiles were considered pagans who did not know the true God. Jesus is a savior for both Jews and Gentiles.
  - \_\_\_\_\_: All those who are truly "*born again*" will be kept by God's power and will persevere as Christians until the end of their lives, and only those who persevere until the end have been truly "*born again*."
  - \_\_\_\_\_: The teaching that the Church has replaced Israel in God's plan. The Jews are no longer God's chosen people, and God does not have specific plans for the nation of Israel. Romans 11 offers a strong challenge to Replacement Theology.
