- _____: A short passage expressing praise to God, often used in worship. Certain passages in Scripture are considered doxologies, like Romans 16.25-27.
- _____: A mystery in the New Testament is something that had at one time been hidden but is now revealed to God's people, namely salvation through Jesus Christ.
- _____: The word *gospel* literally means *good news*. Broadly speaking it is the whole of Scripture, but more narrowly it is the good news about Jesus and the way of salvation.
